Theme Scripture

“Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.”

1 Corinthians 4:2 (KJV)

Purpose of the Financial Fast

This fast is not merely about money—it is about trust, discipline, obedience, and preparation. We are fasting from unnecessary spending while intentionally setting money aside as an act of faith and stewardship.

General Guidelines

During this fast:

Avoid unnecessary purchases (eating out, impulse buying, luxury spending).

Pray before spending, not after.

Save daily, according to the schedule below.

Keep a journal noting what God reveals about your relationship with money.

Give thanks daily—even while saving.
